hilly terrain and lofty slopes make this a trekkers' paradise and prominent trekking trails lead to Matheran via Rambagh Point, Peth Fort and Chanderi Fort. If you feel adventurous I recommend the white water rafting especially during the monsoon, on the upper part of the Ulhas River but you must exercise caution as the tides can be heavy.

The Ulhas valley is set amidst verdant nature and the Bhor Ghat which is in proximity, has a historical significance being part of an ancient trade route. You can also visit the Kondave Buddhist caves that offer a peak into the lifestyle of Buddhist followers. Then there is the Peth Fort located on the rear of the Western ghats and Matheran ranges that has an amazing view of the foothills.
