


# 4 MUST-HAVE APPS FOR SOLO WOMEN TRAVELLERS





## ONEASSIST


## AIRBNB

## GOOGLE TRANSLATE

The app also has a conversation mode and offers two-way instant speech translation in 32 languages. Offline translation, including instant translation from English to most Indian languages (including Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Marathi, Tamil, Telugu and Urdu) are available.
